Minutes of the Previous Meeting – approved unanimously, no matters arising

Financial Update:

CC updated the Committee as follows:

Over £15k in the bank account. Income was from Year 2 cake sale (£121), Loved Ones sale (£245 profit) and also money has started to come in from disco ticket sales.

There is £1,840 allocated but not yet paid out of the PTA account. Mrs McNally is coordinating with CC regarding claiming any outstanding monies from PTA before financial year end.

Grant Applications/Outcomes: none to report

Requests for Funding – Swimming coaches – request for £555 towards transport. It was agreed with School that parents would be asked to contribute £5 per coach trip for swimming eg 6 sessions = £30 requested from parents. The balance would be covered by PTA. This approach would be implemented going forward for consistency of charges to parents. If the coach cost rose in future years, parents may be approached for more than £5 per trip but hopefully the costs will stabilise.

Shed

Further to previous discussions, the location of the shed has been changed and it is likely to be placed at the side of the KS1 double doors to the hall. MW will seek 3 new quotes to enable this to move forward. AM suggested asking Atlas Sheds as they have provided previously and can offer a base that the shed will sit on to simplify installation.

RH offered that Matt Honeyborne could come and advise if needed.

Query was raised about what would happen in Y3 area where shed originally was going to be placed. MW/AM suggested they may look at an awning for shelter from the rain in the future.

Affiliate Promotions

Stikins and easyfundraising.

Keep promoting throughout the year. Suggestions for promoting these:

- There may be an open day in April, depending on Reception place applications
- There is a new parents open evening in June
- Have leaflets at cake sales
- Promote in Summer term ready for labelling for the following September

Preloved Uniform

It was suggested that the new parents evening/day could lend itself to selling the younger aged uniform as we have accumulated quite a lot in very good condition. CC said it has been done before and sales were limited.

Suggestion that we position the really good condition items 'as good as new' and also pushing how eco-friendly it is which ties in with and supports the School's eco position.

Another idea was to give one or two items free to new parents to encourage use of preloved items or alternatively check if a voucher can be provided to get an item free or discounted from the PTA Events Preloved shop. A voucher could be a could way of driving people to sign up for the PTA Events site and help them become familiar with that and the PTA as well.
