Farming in the Community Area

The school wish to work closely with the local farming community and teach the children about what is grown in the fields around where we live and surrounding the school and how this is done.

The area behind the two portacabins has been earmarked for this space—for raised beds for planting and crop rotation, potting shed, green house and seating and hopefully room for a few more edibles to be grown.



The PTA are going to go out and ask local farming companies and timber merchants for help creating this space. So if you know of anyone that maybe can help with funding or materials then please let us know.
