#### STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

The Friends of Bowes PTA ("The Friends") is a charitable association.

The Friends' objectives and regulations are set out in its Constitution adopted 3 October 2000. Committee members are elected by the members of The Friends at the Annual General Meeting (AGM) held during October or November every year.

Membership of The Friends consists of any parent of a child currently attending Bowes New Southgate Primary School or any current member of staff of Bowes New Southgate Primary School.

#### **OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES**

The aim of The Friends is to advance the education of the pupils of Bowes New Southgate Primary School ("The School") by providing and assisting in the provision of facilities for education at The School.

Furthermore, The Friends may help forge relationships between staff, parents & others associated with The School and engage in activities which support The School & advance the education of its pupils.

#### **ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE**

Through funds raised in 2015/16, The Friends donated £13,000 to The School in 2016/17 which helped to fund a new projector, music box, shed, new books for each classroom, science day workshop and various projects. Through funds raised in 2016/17 it is planned to make £21,000 available for donating to the school in order to fund a specific item or items that the school proposes.

Cake sales held by each year group raised a total of £1,203. The money from each sale was given directly to the classes in that year group to help fund resources such as class trips. The book fairs in November 2016 and May 2017 enabled The School to buy £738 worth of new books.

Fund raising events held in year 2016/17 included: Musical Bingo, Christmas Hamper, Christmas Cards, School Calendar, Adult Quiz night, Easter Egg Raffle, clothes recycling scheme (Phil a Bag), second hand uniform sales, Winter Singalong and the biggest fundraiser the Summer Fair.

As well as each event making profit for The School, they brought the Bowes community together and provided joy for both adults and children.

The Friends organised a Welcome Evening in the first term for new reception parents to introduce and welcome them to The School and The Friends. The Friends have also directly funded and laid on extracurricular activities for the children such as: Mr Marvel at the Welcome Evening, the Christmas disco, a visit from Father Christmas to give out class and nursery gifts, and a children's school quiz.

#### **FINANCIAL REVIEW**

The statement of financial activities shows total cash funds of £24,918 as held on the 30th September 2017 either in The Friends' current account, savings account or cash floats.

In total £500 was raised through voluntary donations, £23,284 was raised through charitable events, £1,203 raised through cake sales and £23 raised through savings interest which provided a total income of £25,010.

Expenditure for the year included administration costs of £607 and fundraising expenditure of £7,827 which totalled £8,433 and when deducted from the Income of £25,018 provided a surplus profit of £16,577.

With respect to donations to the school, a total of £7,819 was donated as follows: a lump sum of £13,000 was made available but only £5,887 was used for purchases, £730 was used to fund extra-curricular children's activities and £1,203 was donated directly to The School's classes.

#### **RESERVES POLICY**

The Committee decided during the AGM, held in October 2016, that the level of reserves that the Friends required throughout the year of 2016/17 to fund events and any planned purchases, would be £3200. The Autumn term leading to Christmas, is generally a busy fundraising period and cash reserves are required to pay for various upfront costs relating to, for example, the Christmas cards, Christmas raffle, Calendar, Disco & Christmas gifts.

#### 1 Accounting Policies

# 1.1 Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Statement of Recommended Practice "Accounting by Charities" (SORP 2005).

#### 1.2 Incoming resources

Income from fund raising activities is recognised as earned when the related goods and services are provided.

#### 1.3 Resources expended

Expenditure is recognised when a liability is incurred.

Costs of generating comprise the direct costs of the fundraising activities and any allocated support costs.

#### 1.4 Allocation of costs

Costs are allocated between direct charitable and other expenditure according to the nature of the cost. Where items invoice more than one category they are apportioned between the categories according to the nature of the cost.

#### 2 Related Party Transactions

The charity trustees were not paid during the year and no charity trustee received any emolument or payment for professional or other services.

#### 3 Investment income

All of the investment income arises from an interest-bearing bank account.
