Instructions: Follow the directions to find the answers around the village.

Keep an eye out for 11 Easter Eggs hidden in windows of shops and businesses and rearrange them to spell out the secret words. The first 100 kids to complete the trail might find a chocolate treat at the end....

11 empty square boxes for rearranging Easter eggs.

During the walk can you count how many of these that you can see:

Post boxes: _____

Bus stops: _____

Start at the top of Eastgate by The Cross. There are 3 eggs to find around here.

1. Who presented the cross and lantern to Bramhope in 1939?

2. Who made the lamp?

3. What location at the cross is 7 letters long?

Head down Eastgate towards the Methodist church and the memorial garden. Look out for another egg on the way.

4. When was the Old town Hall demolished?

5. Which surname appears twice in the roll of honour?

6. When was the memorial garden re-dedicated?

7. What 3 surnames are mentioned on stones laid in 1895?

Continue down Eastgate / Breary Lane towards the parade and park area. There are 2 more eggs to find around here.

8. Who designed the sculpture for Browns of Bramhope?

9. Who provided the grant that funded the play area?

10. What is the name of the area that is now the play area?

11. What year was the Bramhope train tunnel finally completed?

Continue down Breary Lane until you meet Leeds Road, turn right.

12. Find the milestone. What can be found 2 miles away?

13. How many letter O's can you find on the milestone?

14. If you tried to break into David Phillips estate agents, what would happen?!

Head towards Tredgold Avenue. There are 4 more eggs to find when you reach the shops.

15. What number should you call if you need to use the defibrillator?

16. What year does it say the garden displays were funded?

Continue along Leeds Road towards Wynmore Avenue.

17. If you miss the 9am collection at this post box, where could you go for a later collection at 4pm?

18. You can have a rest if your legs get tired. Who donated this?

Cross the road at Fiture and take the path to the right. Don't forget to spot one final egg!

19. Who built the bug hotel?

Continue along the path until you reach The Birches

20. Who created the sculpture 'Triathlon'?

21. Can you name the sports shown on the sculpture?

Walk up The Birches and turn left in to the ginnel before you reach Sandy Walk. Continue up Southfield and turn right on to Long Meadows.

22. What colour door can you see opposite the end of Southfield?

Continue up Long Meadows.

23. How many yellow garage doors can you see on the way up to school? Clue – look on the left-hand side as you walk up.

24. By the post box, what colour school can you find?

25. How many letter P's can you see on the school sign?

During the walk can you count how many of these that you can see:

Start at the top of Eastgate by The Cross. Can you find our 3 hidden eggs?

1. Look at the lamp. There are 3 primary colours here: what are they?

2. Which destination comes last in the alphabet?

Head down Eastgate towards the Methodist church and the memorial garden. Look out for another egg on the way.

3. What colour are the poppy flowers opposite the church?

4. Look at the Roll of honour – can you find a surname which is also something that lives in water? _____

Continue down Eastgate / Breary Lane towards the parade and park area. There are 2 more eggs to find around here.

5. How many hearts are there in Lily's window?

6. Can you count the number of chickens and chicks that are guarding the letters?

7. Which shop is named after a colour?

8. Just after the park there is a box that helps us when it is icy. What colour is it?

Continue down Breary Lane until you meet Leeds Road and turn right.

9. How many 1's can you find on the milestone?

10. How many times does the letter M appear on the milestone?

Head towards Tredgold Avenue. There are 4 hidden eggs to find near the shops.

11. What food item can you see on the sign for the newsagents?

12. When did the Bramhope Deli arrive in the village?

Continue along Leeds Road towards Wynmore Avenue.

13. What 2 letters are underneath the picture of the crown on the post box?

After you have passed Ficture, take the path on the right and head for the bug hotel. Don't forget to spot our final egg!

14. What shape is at the top of the bug hotel?

Continue along the path until you reach The Birches

15. What year is on the triathlon sculpture?

Walk up The Birches and turn left in to the ginnel /path before you reach Sandy Walk. Continue up Southfield and turn right on to Long Meadows.

16. What colour door can you see opposite the end of Southfield?

Continue up Long Meadows and head towards the school. Here are your final questions:

17. How many yellow garage doors can you see on the way up to school? Clue for parents – look on the left-hand side as you walk up.

18. By the post box, what colour school can you find?

19. How many letter P's can you see on the school sign?

20. What are the 4 colours that represent the 4 houses at school?
