School Disco

We are very excited about the school disco which is being held on Thursday 15th December. We have sold about 140 tickets and look forward to welcoming the children on the night. As you will be aware, we are trialling a new format for entry and exit into the disco. We ask for parents and carers to bring their children to the external doors of the school hall and stay with them until they are safely signed into the disco. At the end of the disco, children will be asked to sit down in their year group, and parents will be invited into the hall (again via the external entrance) to find their children. Children and parents/carers will be directed out of the front entrance of the school where members of the BSA will ensure that each child is with an appropriate adult.

We will not be selling tickets on the night, but as we had a surge of ticket requests on Thursday and Friday last week, we understand that some parents may not have purchased their tickets in advance. We will therefore be accepting ticket requests until 3:10pm on Tuesday 13th December. You can obtain a copy of the permission form on our website. Tickets will be issued by Wednesday 14th December and will be sent home via the going home trays.
