Big Brookhurst Curry Night – Friday 12th February

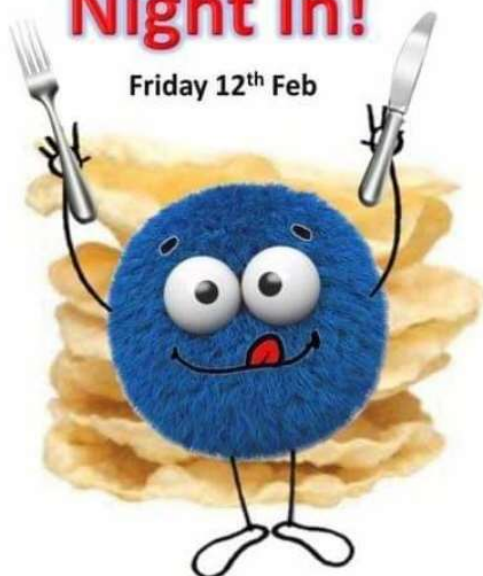
