Get to know a tree

Trees are amazing. Not only do they live for hundreds of years, but they also give us oxygen, slow down global warming and are home to many animals and birds.

Look out for trees when you're outdoors.

- Which is your 'favourite'?
- What does the tree feel like when you touch it?
- What does it smell like?
- Is it deciduous or evergreen?

A deciduous tree loses its leaves in the winter, while an evergreen tree keeps its leaves all year round.

Can you do a bark rubbing?

Place a piece of paper on a tree, then rub over it with crayons. Use the pages at the back of the book to stick in your bark rubbing!

Did you know?

You can find out how old a tree is by counting the rings inside its trunk.
