Primary Schools across UK are facing deficit budget in 2023 - 2024

New figures show that 49% of primary schools had an in-year deficit in 2022/23, while 50% expect to have a deficit in 2023/24 – on top of needing to make cuts to provision. CKIS is not exempt from this reality – we have had to set a deficit budget for the last two consecutive years in order to continue to deliver the high-level of provision to our children in a financial climate where costs have been rising.
