The Clare House Parent Teacher Association (PTA) would very much like to welcome you and your children to the school.

The PTA is a charity which raises money to provide Clare House with equipment and resources that will enhance your child's learning during their time at the school. We do this through a range of fundraising activities which we believe help to create a sense of community.

We've raised a total of £48,000 for the school since 2017, and we hope to continue to raise funds this year!

The funds raised over the years have paid for the Clare House Library and enabled us to provide our children with swimming lessons, educational equipment, laptops, iPads and a high quality music programme.

How do we raise money?

The majority of our funds are raised through organised events. These typically include a Christmas and Summer Fair, an annual quiz night, Spooky Disco, Film Night, Easter Egg Hunt and Ping Pong Night.

In current times, we're developing some exciting new ideas so that we can continue to raise vital funds for the school. These shall likely include select fun virtual events, so that everyone's safety is protected.

Role of the Class Representatives

The Committee oversees the day-to-day running of the PTA and organises fundraising events. The Volunteer Bank is made up of parents/carers who want to help on a more informal basis rather than joining the committee.

You can get involved with the PTA on many different levels, according to your preference and the time you have available.

You can also show your support by donating a raffle prize or sponsoring an event. You can donate time, money, items for sale, prizes or offers of services and skills. For example, recent donations included a Google mobile phone.
