







- Since September we have successfully moved the second hand uniform store online which has made it easier for parents to buy things throughout the year.

Committee nominations










- SR asked about provision for children to attend holiday clubs during the school holidays, this was felt to be something the school are better placed to provide but the PTA are looking at ways to support socialisation of the children and are working on ideas to do this. Including making links with NEAT who are now running sessions in Court Road Recreation Ground.
- RW asked if there was anything the parents thought the school needed that the PTA could fund.
- CH suggested that a Living Wall and some planting around the playground would improve the air quality for the children and also give the children something to look after.
- HM asked if the school needed any play equipment, RW said there is already a school budget for this and a plan in place to buy more, however if they run out of funds she will let the PTA know.
- RW would like some iPads for the school ideally 30 per year. This is something the PTA can help with and would be helped once we have a community liaison person/group. LN suggested that we could go to local businesses to ask if they would sponsor the cost of one iPad.
