Outstanding BOLE budget probably not needed for remainder of year as we have received donations from Ashridge Garden Centre.

Jess has secured fund matching from her employer (Lennovo) for her volunteer time to paint a school, equates to £120. This can be used for future events but Jess needs formal evidence as a record of her participation. Note this is managed through Benevity, *Hayley to renew listing in July 2023 and update FOBS logo*.

5. PRESIDENT'S REPORT

The Governors have a few questions regarding the system robustness, suitability for the children to use and the school IT technician will be visiting Ranelagh School to review their existing system. School would like to include a new lighting set up and also have the new system in place by Year 6 production on 28th/29th June if possible. System will take 4 days for installation but equipment will need to be ordered in advance. The

Governors could call an emergency meeting when they have had the outstanding queries answered. The supplier has also supplied a similar system to Ranelagh school. Nicola asked if we can get any parents within the school to potentially supply & install this equipment but Jo advised this has been tried unsuccessfully previously and will also take longer to organise.

Jo proposed a vote for FOBS to put £10K towards sound system if the Governors can match this and then we can set up a GoFundMe campaign for the remaining £5K.

13 people present excluding teacher : 11 people voted for the donation with 1 non voter and one non eligible member.

- 6.5 Playground bench replacement school would prefer composite benches as they are maintenance free (approx. £380-£600 vs £170-£280 for wood depending on size. We could ask local businesses or parents to sponsor a bench. To be reviewed after decision made on the sound system.

School are aware we need some photos, Jo to organise on Wednesday 17th May. Jess to create a poster.

6.7 Year 6 Leavers Pen audit

Previous pens have had the school name not FOBS (Jess shared a picture online. Pens are 70p each with a pouch. Order size needs to be 250 (approx. 4 years worth) to ensure the low price (approx. £200 total). Claire advised that year 6 responsibility ties are also needed for September, approx. £2.20 each, £300 total to cover 2 years. Unanimous vote to proceed with both purchases.

6.8 FOBS recruitment drive

Jo & Jess have created a new "We need you" poster for the OWL noticeboards and this was also shared in the school newsletter on 12th May. Jess & Jo have created a publicity strategy campaign for sharing with new starter parents and for existing parents via book bags. The plan is also to engage children to promote FOBS. Tania suggested creating a large visual display in the playground of what FOBS support.
