#### **Reflection Garden -**

The total held in our account for the Reflection Garden at Year End was £2009.62 - this was raised through Donation Campaigns, a contribution from FOMP, money donated from the Year 2019-20 Year 6 Leavers Committee and the proceeds from the very successful Break the Rules day in the summer term.

#### Year 6 Leavers -

The Year 6 Leavers Committee work alongside FOMP to raise money to purchase leavers gifts and put on a celebration for the Year 6 pupils each year. FOMP also provides a donation of up to £500 each year towards this. This year the profit/loss figures show the committee raised a fantastic £1277.82 through donations and events including a Virtual Quiz and an Easter Bunny Trail and spent £1692.62 so the final FOMP contribution was £414.80.
