


Mandy Bunny has been busy visiting different areas around Mandeville School. She wants to tell Mrs Longhurst where she's been but can't remember all the places! Follow her trail below and see if you can help spot where she took each photograph.

1. Mandy Bunny started at Mandeville School. Find the sign post outside school.



Where does the sign at the top of the post point to?

2. With the school behind you, turn left and head towards Abbots Avenue West. You'll pass a row of shops. Mandy thinks the trees outside look very pretty.



What is the name of the general store?

3. Mandy stopped to look at the hoardings with the bright designs that Mandeville students helped paint. Something is different about her photo.



What is missing in the picture when compared to the real boards?

4. Walk down the big double road until you reach Cottonmill Lane. On the way, Mandy spots a post box.



What time is the post picked up on Saturday?

5. Turn right and look for Old Oak on your left (be careful crossing the road here! Make sure you are listening to your adult). Go down into the Marlborough Pavilion Green Space. Mandy has a good run around here until she is tired. She stops by the basketball court.



The sign shows a basketball but what is the other ball on the sign?

6. Go back onto Cottonmill Lane and walk back up the other side of Abbots Avenue West. At the turning into Berners Drive, Mandy sees a signpost.



How far away is London Colney (the sign is in km)?

7. Turn right onto Berners Drive. Mandy likes playing on the swings in the playground at the other end of Berners Drive!



As she hops, Mandy passes a road on her right, can you spot what it is called?

8. Walk down Berners Drive until you reach the Level Crossing over the railway. If you are lucky you may see a train – don't forget to wave at the driver! Be careful when crossing over,



Mandy's big ears help her hear trains but you need to stop, look and listen. Mandy notices an important message – what must you remove before crossing?

9. Can you see the sign for Grindcobbe? Go up Grindcobbe and onto Trumpington Drive.



On the way, you'll pass a couple of big yellow bins. What is kept in them?

10. Turn right into Maynard Drive. Half way along, Mandy spots a bus stop.



What road name is written in the yellow box on the bus stop?

11. Walk to the end of Maynard Drive and turn left onto Tavistock Avenue. Mandy spots another bus stop.



What is the number of the bus that stops here?

12. Follow Tavistock Avenue as it turns to the left. You'll reach a little horseshoe green. Mandy enjoys jumping around the trees.



How many trees are there?

On the left hand side of the green is a footpath through the houses. Follow it past the garages and back to Mandeville School! Phew, Mandy is pretty tired now and is going to rest on the benches! **Well done, you deserve a rest now too!**
