- SJC highlighted a number of fundraising events from last year including own clothes day, Summer Ball (£8k), Second Hand Uniform sales (£3k), Raffles (£3k), Christmas Cards & Fitness on the astro.
- SJC shared also the list of funded requests from the last year, namely:
 - Polydron Magnet Sets (indoor)
 - 3 Giant Polydron playground sets
 - Playground Equipment
 - Sewing Machine and Light boxes for extra-curricular clubs
 - Crossways 'Transition to Secondary School' sessions for both Year 6 classes
 - Visit to Trinity Theatre for all year groups to see The Prince & The Pauper
 - Visit to Assembly Halls for Jack & The Beanstalk
 - End of term disco (x2)

2. Treasurers Report

- MG noted that FOM currently has c. £23.8k in the bank, with £20k reserved for the gym refurb
- MG shared that we should reiterate the "easy fundraising" link to all year groups, as this can generate funds from little effort
- MG noted that once the gym has been paid for, we will be running at a more 'normal' operating balance, we have been sitting on a large amount of funds for some time

3. Funding Requests

- Mrs Wilson has raised a funding request for more playground equipment, this is approximately the same as last year's request. FOM agreed that we are happy to approve this for every year, on condition that it is matched by Wishford.
- Library This request has been around since 2019, looking to progress asap. SJC will meet with Mrs King after half term, to agree how the books which are no longer needed for the library will be managed eg we can take to Oxfam on the Pantiles >>Action
- An Anti Bullying workshop has been proposed for KS1 & KS2, at a cost of £395. Other
 workshops have been proposed, including a parent workshop around anxiety in children,
 first aid, and sleeping problems. FOM are happy to subsidise these workshops, as long as
 the topics are agreed as relevant at these meetings.
- Sewing Machines have also been proposed we have 2 on loan which it would be useful to purchase, these help with clubs and the show costumes. Fee to be confirmed, but FOM agreed to fund.
- KH raised that we should look at audio equipment, difficult to hear Mr Westwell at sports day etc. >>Action: MC to look into this and revert
