1. Easter (SJC)

- SJC noted that the Easter disco has been booked for 30 March, 240 eggs have been purchased. SJC is following up on specialist eggs for children with allergies/intolerances
- SJC shared that we will charge £1 per child for own clothes day
- San Danby is not available for the Easter bunny role, and AM is away remains TBC

2. May Ball (SJC)

- SJC noted that Salomon's has been booked for 21st May, she is currently finalising the ticketing site, this will launch soon
- SJC shared that it will be 10 people per table, wine will be booked directly through Salomons via an Excel form, once SJC confirms table number
- Ticket covers a welcome drink, 3 course meal & entertainment
- SJC noted that Melissa is leading the decorating team, using Salomon's direct supplier
- Teachers will get tickets for the ball at cost
- There will be a silent auction on the night, we need 6 prizes to add our own lots to this auction
- We also need to look at sponsors, we have a main sponsor, but need some £300 sponsors

3. Meadfest (SJC)

- SJC shared that she has been looking at lining up vendors for Meadfest, which will be held on September 10th this year
- The inflatables company are unavailable MG shared that we can look at KBS inflatables instead. We my need volunteers to man the inflatables, if they can provide the inflatables only.
- The marquee people have confirmed the date, after last year they should hopefully be keen to deliver a better service
- Electrics Nathan has offered to assist for 1 last year, on the basis that he will have someone to train this year who can take over from next year

- Sumup machines there is some confusion over how these operate RW will take these and review with MG, RW will organise the bar this year
- MG noted that we need to book the deckchairs SJC will follow up
- Theme RW suggested "Mardi Gras" which was agreed by all
- We can have a maximum of 499 people, therefore can sell 450 tickets for the event

- SJC is working on the newsletter, which will come out in March this will include an update on the gym, once we receive from the school
