1-2. Food / Drink vendors:

- MC has offered to take the lead on this and reconfirm / coordinate
- Pizza Van confirmed
- Mimi Coco Chocolates confirmed
- Timeless Temptations confirmed (candyfloss, popcorn, slushies)
- Basil are due to provide tea, coffee & cake //UPDATE: Have now dropped out

• Fritto Via have pulled out so we need BBQ option. MC suggested the caterers at the Mead as a supplier //UPDATE: Now confirmed

1-3. Logistics / Estates:

- Clive has been volunteered by AJ. EK has a spreadsheet of who needs power & how much. Nathan will be available on the day to support.
- Carlos will be on-hand to help again (need to agree payment)
- Entrance feedback from last year on how to better manage this. Garland selling last year caused a bottleneck, people did not turn up for shifts as they clashed with their children's performances.
- Bathrooms / clean up team needed MC noted that we can ask the cleaning team to come in on Sunday for this >>Action: MC to confirm
- Deckchairs ordered
- Marquee confirmed

- MG will order additional sump machines >>Action

- Balloon arch will be done at cost
- Looking for some pretty umbrellas to decorate behind the bar
