Re: Matched Funding Scheme

There is a fantastic scheme whereby many companies will match their employers fundraising efforts for organisations such as our PA. As part of their Corporate Social Responsibility programs, many companies encourage staff to get involved in community projects, including Christmas Bazaar, May Fete, Fireworks Nights, Cake Sales etc, by offering to match any funds they raise.

The idea is that you are assigned to one particular aspect of a fundraising event (e.g. a table/stall, games, raffle, etc) and then your employer will match the amount you raise in that area. In most cases, the company will match your donation pound for pound up to a specified amount.
