Become a Friend of Kingham Primary School

Dear Kingham Primary Parents, Guardians and Grandparents,

This year KPSA are fundraising to create an Outdoor Learning Hub filled with resources and equipment to really make the most of the forest area and new pond, and create many more outdoor learning opportunities for all classes. Every year, we also fund workshops, buy equipment, and provide unrestricted grants for each class to buy extra resources to enhance their class topics and bring learning to life.

We all know that school budgets are under enormous pressure. This year Kingham Primary School has just 4.5 pence of every £1 in its budget to spend on learning resources, materials and classroom supplies. That's less than £5 per child each week to cover everything. Any additional money that we raise will therefore directly benefit all our children and really enrich their education.

We set up the 'Friends of Kingham Primary School' to recognise those who support the School by making a regular donation each month or year. Giving regularly is the simplest and most effective way to support children at Kingham. What's more, as a charity, KPSA can claim Gift Aid on your donations, which unlocks an extra 25p from the government for every £1 given, at no additional cost to you.


I hope that you will join me by giving 50p a day to support Kingham Primary School this year. You can see that if our community work together we could provide so many more resources and opportunities across the whole school. There really is strength in numbers.

- If every family gave 50p per day (£15 a month) we would raise over £30,000 each year, after Gift Aid has been reclaimed. This would be transformative.
- If just 35 families went further and gave £1 a day (£30 a month), with Gift Aid we would raise enough to provide an additional £2,000 a year to every teacher to enhance the learning resources for their class.

I hope that every family will support us in whatever way they can, and all donations, whatever the size, are very gratefully received. We are also very grateful for all the time, help, and support parents give. Long may it continue!
