Well done for registering for the Latchmere School Fun Run!

How does a Fun Run work?

- The idea of the event is to raise money for our school by being sponsored to complete as many laps of Dinton Field as you can in 20minutes, along with your friends and family!
- There will be 3 Fun Runs one for KS1 (nursery, reception, Year 1 and Year 2); one for KS2 (Years 3, 4, 5 and 6) and one for the parents!
- Each run will last 20mins, and the aim is to get round Dinton Field as many times as you can. You can do the laps in any way you like run, walk, hop, skip or jump! You can go round with friends, and mums and dads can help you too!
- These are not races the aim is to complete as many laps as possible, but there are no prizes for the fastest lap!
- Each lap is 400m so if you run 4 laps, you will have run a Latchmere mile!
- All KS1 and KS2 runners will receive medals and goodie bags.
- Prizes will be awarded for the best fancy dress in each run.

How do I get sponsored?

Getting sponsored means asking people to give you money for doing something amazing! We're asking you to get people to sponsor you for running the fun run - the idea is that they give you a little bit of money for each lap that you run around Dinton Field, so the more laps you complete, the more money you'll raise for school! You can either set up a JustGiving page or use a sponsorship form (available to download or from the school office).

What will happen on the day?

10:00 Gates open

A festival atmosphere all morning with coffee and snacks by Canbury Secret, ice cream, music and bouncy castle (free unlimited access for those with bouncy castle / family registration) KS1 runners pick up their race numbers

- 10:15 KS1 warm up
- 10:20 KS1 run starts run as many laps as you can!
- 10:40 KS1 run finishes and runners collect their medals and goodie bags KS2 runners pick up their race numbers and start to line up
- 10:55 KS2 warm up
- 11:00 KS2 run starts run as many laps as you can!
- KS2 run finishes and runners collect their medals and goodie bags
- 11:30 Parents warm up
- 11:30 Parents' run starts run as many laps as you can!
- 11:50 Parents' run finishes
- Prize giving
- 12:00 Gates close
