



EVENT DOs & DON'Ts

Do

- ☺ Check your phone/email on the day if the weather is not looking good. Drizzle will not stop us, but relentless downpours will.
- ☺ Supervise your children at all times - they remain your responsibility!
- ☺ Bring a torch if you are camping, and additional lighting for your tent as it gets very dark at night.
- ☺ Ensure children are accompanied to the toilet after lights out.
- ☺ Always wear your wrist band and write a contact number on all children's wrist bands.
- ☺ Volunteer to help out on a stall or shift on an activity – it takes lots of people to make this event a success.
- ☺ Re-use your drinking vessels – we want to be as sustainable as possible so please buy a re-useable cup and bring it back each time to limit plastic usage. If you want to bring your own plastic cup you are welcome to do so.
- ☺ Please remember that children are **NOT** allowed in the Wildlife area at school. Please tell them not to go in this area whilst at the camp out. We will have signs up and no-entry tape.
- ☺ Remember that we are in a residential area and try to be considerate of our neighbours, especially as it gets late.

Don't

- ☹ Please don't bring any kind of stove or gas cylinder. Personal cooking is not allowed.
- ☹ Don't park in the school car park – access is needed throughout the event. You may use the car park for unpacking tents and equipment only, then please park outside the school.
- ☹ Please don't bring your own alcohol or music player - we will have the usual well stocked bar and a great music system.
- ☹ Don't try to get into the main school - we have access to toilets and water in the Y6 Cabin.
