

94%
of schools said that
COVID-19 had a
'somewhat negative' or
'very negative' impact
on their fundraising.



98%
of schools reported
having to cancel
fundraising events as a
result of COVID-19



80%
of schools stated that

96% of schools expect COVID-19 to continue affecting their ability to raise funds in the next academic year






Meet us at the AGM!
