Latest Funding

Following the amazing fundraising season we just had, raising £10,864, we wanted to share with you how some of our funds have recently been spent at Oakwood! If you have any ideas on how they can be spent please send us a form by February 21st or come to our meeting on February 28th in person where we will be voting on how the funds are spent.

£140 online panto and popcorn which the kids love in the run up to the end of term

£54 on fully eco-friendly crackers for their school dinner celebration

£40 on the outdoor Christmas Tree

£80 Mini Trampette for Acorns to help with motor skills and balance

£40 2 x toasters for Acorns to support their good food initiative

£200 on Diversity Books for KS1 suggested by a parent to support exposure to diverse family

£200 on Hockey sticks and balls for KS1 to encourage more sport and improve hand/eye coordination

£116 on Outdoor Chess Sets for KS2 to encourage play and strategic games

£330 on Crates for KS2 to allow older children to continue their love of building and imaginative play on the junior playground like the infants have £300 on UKS2 books to improve reading corners and provide more challenging texts

£1,300 on SEN equipment for the whole school £1,000 on whole school science workshop
