What to wear & bring with you

1. T-Shirts & Wrist Bands

- Will be provided to all participants
- Pupils will be given theirs in class on the afternoon of the colour run
- Everyone else taking part will have theirs sent home with pupils in the days before

2. Trousers or shorts

- Make sure pupils take these to school with them

3. Trainers

- Make sure pupils take these to school with them

4. Goggles or glasses

- The paint powder is washable and free of toxins, those with sensitive eyes may wish to wear eye protection

5. Inhalers or medication

- Any items usually left on site will not be accessible as entrance to the school building will be limited

6. Money

- Both cash and card payments will be accepted at the bar and BBQ, plus the ice-cream and merchandise stands.

- Children collected from their classrooms as per usual
- All participants head to the school field
