The Building of our New **Trim Trail is Underway!**

The PFA are really pleased to announce that work has now started on our new £22,000 investment 'All Age Trim Trail' to help pupils keep fit and active whilst at school. Trails are the perfect way to get children outdoors and encourage exercise.

The impressive trim trail which is Somersham Primary School's biggest investment in recent years has been funded by all your generous donations and spending at the PFA events over several years to the value of £8,000. We also had a generous donation from School Council for £2,000 which was kindly match funded by Barclays Bank for a further £2,000.



We then made a application to the Awards for All, Big Lottery Grant. Fantastic news of the £10,000 grant award from the National Lottery has given the new play equipment the green light and has meant we can achieve this installation much sooner than we hoped!

The new trim trail will include some really exciting and challenging pieces of equipment for the children, including a log cabin, wobble board, log walk, clatter bridge, tyre traverse, mini web, striding stilts, included twine and cross beams. The trail will be built on a dedicated part of the school field using special purpose surfaces for the children's safety.

PFA Chair, Vicki Webb described the new trim trail as "absolutely fantastic". "It has been a long time coming but will provide the 'Wow Factor' and will become a real focal point for the school." "It will help keep the children fit and active which ties in with our healthy school initiative" "We are most grateful to everyone who has supported the PFA over the years, the School Council and Barclays Bank and also the National Lottery for their large donation which has helped make this happen.".
