

Nine New Visualisers Ordered

The PFA are really pleased to be able to purchase a further nine visualisers, costing £300 each. The visualizers will be used in the School Classrooms as a result from our annual fundraising efforts.

These visualizers can really help the teachers ensure the quality of teaching in lessons is consistently high. By sharing outcomes of pupils work, demonstrating and modelling techniques and methods under a visualizer can help ensure that pupils make good progress and have a clear understanding in lessons.

For example, when teaching angles in mathematics, the visualizer allows a teacher to demonstrate how to use a protractor to accurately measure angles in a way that could not be easily achieved otherwise.

Second Hand Uniform


