



SRSA 100 CLUB RULES

Purpose

The purpose of the 100 club is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the SRSA bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for students.

Rules

1. For a cost of £2 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between one and 100.
2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
3. The prizes will total 50% of the annual income.
4. This will be apportioned as: 1st prize of 50%, 2nd prize of 30% and 3rd prize of 20% for 10 out of 12 months. There won't be a prize draw in August and September so the prizes for July and December will be double the monthly income.
5. The 100 club is a private lottery and is open to all, staff, parents, carers and friends of Sussex Road School. Anyone aged 16 or over can join.
6. Numbers are limited to two per household.
7. Payments must be made online for a year's membership and subscriptions will renew at the beginning of each academic year. The renewal period lasts for one calendar month during September.
8. Member's numbers will only be entered each year if their subscription is renewed.
9. If subscriptions are not renewed within the 'renewal period' the number may be sold to someone on the reserve list and the member shall be deemed to have left the 100 club.
10. The draw shall be made by a member of the SRSA with at least one other adult present in the last week of each month.
11. The winning money will be paid by bank transfer to the account provided on your membership application within one week of the draw.
12. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted in the SRSA newsletter, Twitter and Facebook.
13. The 100 club will be run by the SRSA. In case of any dispute the decision of the committee is final.
14. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into SRSA funds after six months.
