Time of event

This event is only for students at St Wilfrid's Catholic Primary School.

The Smeds and the Smoos for KS1, Y1&2 & Reception: 3:15pm to 4pm

Onwards for KS2 Year 3-Y6: 4:15pm to 6:15pm

Reception, Y1&2 will go directly from class to the Hall. They will remain in school uniform. Mats will be provided for Reception and KS1 so they can all sit together on the Hall floor.

KS2, Y3-Y6 will need to be dropped off at 4:15 and can wear home clothes.

KS2 students are also welcome to bring in a pillow or small beanbags to sit on.

Mats will be available if needed.

Snack Bags:

Snack bags will be provided. These will include popcorn, a bag of sweets (Haribo) and a Fruit Shoot. If your child has an allergy to any of these there is allocation to provide these details at the end of the reservation process and we will do our best to provide an alternative.

Water will also be available.

Dropping off and collecting your child

Please drop off at the front of school, reception area. Children will then say goodbye and walk in past the office to the registration area firstly and then into the hall.

For collection, parents can arrive via the same route, walk into the hall and leave with their child via the hall door which leads onto KS2 playground and out of the KS2 gates.

Please arrive promptly to collect.

Parking

We envisage that there will be a large volume of traffic in and around the school. If you do need to drive to the event, please be considerate to pedestrians and our neighbours when parking and allow reasonable time.

Ear Defenders

If you have ear defenders, and think that your child may require them, please ensure that they are brought to the Movie Night and are clearly named. We also will have a supervised quiet area, if required.

Does your child have additional needs?

If your child has any additional needs, it is the parents' responsibility to make us aware at least 48 hours before the event and agree support required. (E.g., parent accompanies child to event)
