



SPR Whitewater Fun Run Event Program

1. Event

The event is a Fun Run open to Children over the age of 3 on the day of the event, this will take place of an approx. 2000m trail course starting and finishing at the Whitewater CofE School in Rotherwick. Children under the age of 8 must be accompanied by a responsible adult to the Event. The accompanying adult wish to run the course they can (only one adult per child).

This is a fun run, so no timing facilities will be available.

5. Race Entries

Entry costs £10 per first child then £2 for any other child taking part from the same family, this also includes one Adult free (note: Adults running for free do not receive a medal or goody bag).

Entries will also be available on the day from the Registration Marquee providing maximum numbers have not been exceeded.

6. Race Numbers

Race numbers will be available to pick-up on the morning of the event at the Registration Marquee, this will be open from 9:45am on the morning of the event in the front playground of the school, see map below.





7. Parking

Permission has been granted for us to use the Yard and freestanding at A.Steel & Sons across from the school, this is limited to a maximum of 48 vehicles. This will be open for parking from 9:30am, marshals will be present to direct you, see map below.

There is additional parking available on the road, please be sure not to block any driveways.

DO NOT use the car park at The Coach and Horses Public House, this is for patrons only.







8. Facilities

No toilet facilities will be provided.

Refreshments will be available at the School Summer Fair that commences at 11:00am, straight after the run in the main school field.

9. The Course

The course is a multi-terrain two-lap course, starting from the main field at the School on public footpaths, this will be clearly marked and marshalled at all turnings and junctions by volunteers. (See map below).

Every effort will be made to identify and mark any hazards, i.e. tree routes, rabbit holes etc., but please remember that participation is at your own risk.
